

Home Learning Class 2

Literacy

- Keep a daily record/journal of your time at home over the next few weeks. When keeping a diary, write in the first person and the past tense.
- Write a newspaper front page about Arthur pulling the sword from the stone. You will need to include the **5Ws- who, what, why, when, where**. Also, there will need to be an eye-catching headline (you could include alliteration or a play on words) and a picture. Think carefully about the name of your newspaper. Don't forget to write in columns! Visit www.storiestogrowby.org sword in the stone to remind yourselves of the story.
- Watch a film and write a review of it. You will need a synopsis of the plot (a summary of what happens); the characters in it; what you liked about it; which characters were your favourite and who you would recommend it to.
- Create a poster based on the film instead of writing a review.
- Cook a meal and write instructions on how to do it. remember to include 'bossy' verbs. It should be written in the present tense and the second person (i.e 'you will need...', roll out the pastry etc). Email photos of your meal.
- Invent a new board game. Play it with your family.
- Write a biography of your favourite author.
- Read every day. Make sure that you continue to make a note in your reading records of the books you have read.
